CASA LA JOYA Chardonnay Reserva 2007

- Chile

Bright and flavourful, floral and lively, this Chardonnay echoes pear and vanilla on its long finish.

MARLBOROUGH PARK Sauvignon Blanc 2008

- Australia

Herbal and green pepper aromas, grapefruit flavours with refreshing and lingering acidity and finish.

TORRESELLA Pinot Grigio 2008/09 - Italy

Clear dry white with pale straw colour. Characteristic mellow aromas that's smooth and delicate on the palate. Fresh and well balanced.

CASTELO DE LA DEHESA 2008 - Spain

Blended 50% Verdejo, 50% Sauvignon Blanc having straw yellow color with greenish iridescences, clean and bright this wine has intense aromas of apple, newly mown grass and tropical fruits, it is balanced, well structured wine.

RED HOUSE WINES

DOMINO DE LAERTES 2006 - Rioja, Spain

Black cherry color with a deep red rim. On the nose it displays a set of very balsamic scents: Cinnamon, berries, red fruits. The entry on the palate is round, ample, with a well finished coupling of fruit and wood and integrated acidity. The finish is long and expressive.

TRAPICHE Cab. Sauvignon 2008 - Argentina

Made from 100% Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. It has a bouquet of walnuts and hazelnuts. Soft and balanced on the palate, with a pleasant, long finish and firm tannins.

RAWNSLEY Shiraz Viognier 2006 - S. Australia

Full bodied and well rounded with plum notes. Spicy palate with fruit notes of black currant and blackberry.

TAHUNA Pinot Noir 2009 - New Zealand

The Tahuna Noir has concentrated black cherry and dark berry aromas which follow through to the palate where dark berry fruit and cherry flavours are supported by soft tannins. This is a ripe and deeply coloured food wine, designed for early drinking

WHITE WINES



BERESFORD Pinot Chardonnay NV - McLaren Vale, Australia \$ 340

This sparkling wine has the bouquet of lifted green apples, bread dough with a hint of cherry. Creamy mousse complements refreshing fruit flavours with a clean acid finish.

GRAN VINO SOL Chardonnay Miguel Torres, 2006 - Spain \$ 298

Full bodied, intensely aromatic blend of chardonnay and parellada. Grassy notes with pineapple overtones. Full body and not acidic.

OYSTER BAY Sauvignon Blanc 2009 – New Zealand \$ 370

Pale straw green in colour with brilliant clarity, Oyster Bay Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is zesty and aromatic with lots of lively, penetrating fruit characters. A concentration of tropical and gooseberry flavours with an abundant bouquet, it is a wine that is always crisp, elegant and refreshing.

SANTA MARGHERITA Pinot Grigio 2008/09 - Italy \$ 298

This dry white wine is pale straw-yellow in color. The clean, intense aroma and dry flavor with pleasant golden apple aftertaste make. Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio a wine of great character and versatility.

TAHUNA Sauvignon Blanc, 2009 – New Zealand \$ 270

Classic gooseberry and tropical fruit characters with fresh acidity giving focus to the fruit flavours. This is an excellent food wine and is made for drinking over 2-3 years.

DOMAINE PAUL BLANCK Riesling 2007/08 – France \$ 330

Clear, brilliant, white with pale green in color. Beautiful citrus fruits aromas, floral, honeysuckle, grapefruit. With lemony attack, fine and fresh, full mid-palate, citrus, green apple freshly cut. Long finish.

DOMAINE LAROCHE Chablis Saint Martin 2008 – France \$ 428

Crystal clear with hints of pale green, subtle flavors with a hint of undergrowth and citrus. Rich and aromatic, balanced by a classical mineral structure. Good harmonious persistence.

SHAW AND SMITH Sauvignon Blanc 2009 – Australia \$ 350

The wine is unwooded to maximise varietal punch. The aroma has restrained sauvignon grassiness coupled with riper fruit characters. The palate is fresh and lively with pure fruit varietal flavours and crisp acidity.

LES DOMANIERES ROSE 2008 Cotes De Provence – France \$ 350

The freshness of iodine, with citrus and honey flavours.

BERESFORD BEACON HILL Unwooded Chardonnay 2006 - Australia \$ 298

Lifted aromas of grapefruit and pineapple, attractive texture on the palate, full length flavor and soft round finish.

RED WINES



WARBURN ESTATE Cabernet Merlot 2008 – Australia \$ 298
Hints of vanillin oak aromas are present on the nose, the palate has rich ripe plum, black currant and spice flavors with a fleshy texture and balances the lingering supple tannins.

SHAW AND SMITH Shiraz 2007 – Australia \$ 410
Ripened slowly and evenly resulting in intense colour, pepper spice flavours and great intensity.

PETER LEHMANN MENTOR Cabernet 2004 – Australia \$ 670
Intense brooding blackness color & nose of opulence of classical Barossa Cabernet blackcurrants, violets. A great generosity of flavour and velvet fruit reined in by the fine chalky tannins on the finish.

BERONIA Reserva 2005 – Rioja, Spain \$ 350
Smooth from the very first touch to the lingering finish. With velvet textures, well balanced between ripe fruit flavors and drier spice elements that gives the wine a characteristic balsamy impression.

FAUSTINO V Reserva 2004 - Spain \$ 390
Medium to Full Bodied 90 - 95% Tempranillo grape giving richness and earthiness, this fine scented strawberry fruits has one year cask ageing followed by two in the bottle before release.

MARQUES DE RISCAL Reserva 2004/05 - Spain (Half Bottle \$212) \$ 418
Dark cherry colour, balsamic aromas with hints of ripe fruit, complex & spicy. The finish is persistent with some reminders of toasted oak. Pleasant & elegant, fresh and easy to drink.

BLACK COTTAGE Pinot Noir 2008,09 - New Zealand \$ 298
Bursting with perfumed floral, spice and cherry notes. Wine shows good finesse, balance and great length.

CASTELLO DELLA PANERETTA Chianti Classico Riserva Tradizione 2005 - Italy \$390
Deep ruby red color, aromas of crushed raspberry, hints of toasty oak. Medium to full-bodied with delicious fruit, lots of vanilla and wood character on the finish.

ANTARIO BAROLO DODG 2004 – Italy \$ 610
Deep ruby red with a bouquet of violet, spices and pepper. Great depth of character on the palate with classic damson fruit flavours and a good amount of spice.

CHATEAU DE LA COUR Saint Emillion Grand Cru 2003-France \$ 615
Complex wine with notes of blackcurrant and prune, very well balanced in mouth, good structure and persistent length.

CROZES HERMITAGE DOMAINE de Thalabert 2005 - France \$ 728
Intense, complex and aromatic on a blend of red berries and animal notes, deep ruby of the colour, limpid and bright, powerful and fine noble tannins; ample, well-balanced finish.

LUIGI BOSCA Merlot 2005/06 - Argentina \$ 370
A deep garnet, velvety-smooth wine with a profound aroma. On the palate it unfolds flavours of cherry and raspberry with hints of stone fruit and leather overtones.

TRAPICHE Medalla Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 - Argentina \$ 488
Rich and well structured. Intense red colour with purple hues. Slightly smoky aromas of toasted honey and blackberries. Persistent wide taste with ample body and touches of black pepper finish.

TRAPICHE Malbec Single Vineyard 2006 - Argentina \$ 668
Deep red garnet colored Malbec, with sweet aromas of ripe red fruits like cherry and plum. Sweet and ample in the mouth with soft and delicate tannings.
